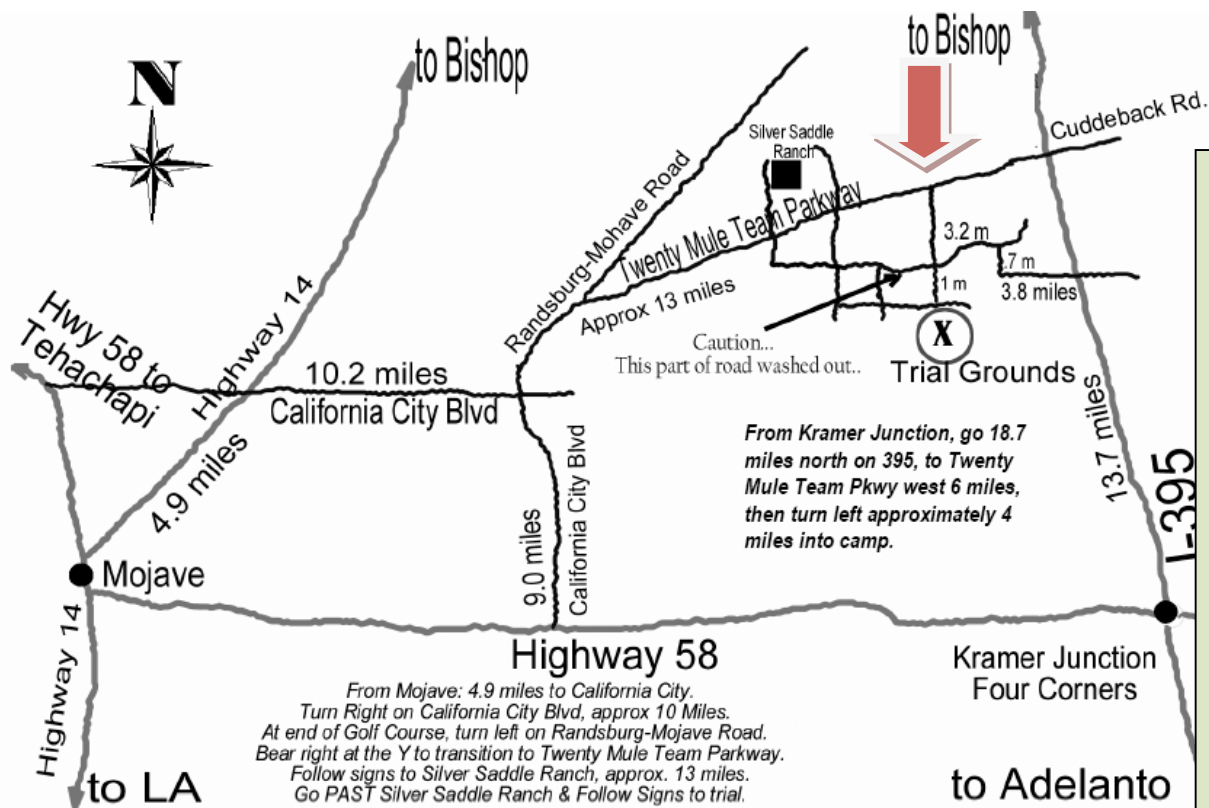


THE ALL IMPORTANT DIRECTIONS



From 395/58

Go North 18.7 miles.

There is a Cal-Trans sign "Twenty Mule Team / Cuddeback" Turn left.

(The first mile is packed dirt, paved after that.)

Go 6.2 mi. Turn left.

Go about 2 miles straight into camp.

Signs will be posted at 395 & at the turn into camp.

Historic Hotel in Randsburg

The Randsburg Inn – 166 Butte Ave – 760-374-2332

This is about 15 minutes closer to the grounds than motels in Mojave. Rooms are limited.

Go North on 395 to Joberg. Turn left. Go .9 mile. (Joberg is .6 mile past Stutter St) Joberg becomes Staley. Take a slight left onto Butte (just past Lexington Pl). 166 is on the left just past Highland Ave. (If you reach S. High St., you've gone too far.)

Camping is permitted on the grounds. There will be a porta-potty & a water tank.

Water will be at the starting line. Weather – Be prepared for anything.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that California City requires a permit for persons operating an ATV within city limits. (This includes Camp H.) The fee is \$10/year (ends June 30th) Fines are \$500. A helmet is also required. Permits can be purchased at "Borax Bill" Park. You can also get them via mail. Go to www.calcitypd.org follow the link to "Permit Program."
